

## Chapter 24

### PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

#### GENERAL REFERENCES

§ 24-1. Commission established.

There is hereby created a Thurmont Planning and Zoning Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

§ 24-2. Composition; terms; compensation; vacancies and appointments.

A. The Commission shall consist of five members and two alternates, each to serve for five years or until his successor takes office, except that the term of the Commissioner of Thurmont named as member shall correspond to his official tenure.

B. All members shall serve without compensation and may be removed by the Commissioners of Thurmont for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance in office. All shall be eligible for reappointment. Vacancies occurring by expiration of term or otherwise shall be filled by appointment of the President of the Commissioners of Thurmont, confirmed by the Commissioners of Thurmont.

§ 24-3. Powers, functions and duties.

The Commission shall have all the powers, functions and duties provided for in Sections 10 through 37 of Article 66B, subtitle "Planning," of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1937 Edition),<sup>1</sup> as the same may be amended from time to time.
