

Chapter 68

ELECTRICAL WIRING AND CONNECTIONS

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Thurmont 11-24-1950. Readopted as revised 1-8-1986 by Res. No. 85-6. Subsequent amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 68-1. Certificate of approval required.¹

No connections for the purpose of transmitting electric current to any new customer or extensions and additions for present customers shall be made for any house, storeroom, building, stable, barn or any outbuilding until the wiring and fixtures in any house, storeroom, building, stable, barn or any outbuilding shall have been inspected and been given assurance of safe installation by a certificate of electrical approval issued by the Frederick County Electrical Inspector or his equivalent.

§ 68-2. Costs of inspection.

The cost of inspection shall be at the expense of the owner of the property being wired.

§ 68-3. Issuance of permit.

Upon approval of the wiring and fixtures by the Inspector, the Town of Thurmont shall issue a permit for the installation of electric current.²
