

CHARTER AMENDMENT BALLOT

RESOLUTION R03-05
TO
AMEND CHARTER ARTICLE V, SECTION C-42
OF THE THURMONT CODE
FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL OF THE TOWN ATTORNEY

(Note: New language is underlined and in cap; old language is in parenthesis)

Section C-42. The President SHALL APPOINT AND REMOVE A TOWN ATTORNEY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS. ((The President with the approval of the Board of Commissioners may appoint a Town Attorney.)) The Town Attorney shall be a member of the Bar of the Maryland Court of Appeals. The Town Attorney is the legal adviser of the town and shall perform such duties in the connection as MAY BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE TOWN OR as may be required from time to time by the President AND ((or)) the Board of Commissioners. His compensation shall be determined by the Board of Commissioners. The BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ((town)) has the power to employ such legal consultants as it deems necessary from time to time.
