Media Release

June 29, 2017

On June 25, 2017 at approximately 2:30pm, Thurmont Police responded to an assault in progress on Sunny Way at Sunny Ct. Upon arrival, the Thurmont Police Officer found three (3) individuals had been involved in a verbal argument which turned physical. Two male subjects and one female were involved in the assault. One of the male subjects, later identified as Joshua Bare, struck the other male with a metal pipe injuring the victim. The assailant (Bare) received a facial injury and had to be taken to the hospital for treatment. On June 28, 2017, Joshua Ray Bare, age 20, of Thurmont, was arrested on a warrant charging him with First and Second Degree Assault, and Reckless Endangerment. Mr. Bare was taken to Central Booking and is being held without Bond pending a Bond Review Hearing.
