## Media Release

April 5, 2019

On April 4, 2019, at approximately 3:00pm, a female victim responded to the Thurmont Police Station to report a domestic assault by her husband. The female was visibly upset and reported to the Police that she had been assaulted for the last two days by her husband, he continuously threatened her, and held her at the residence against her will. The victim showed physical signs of the assaults. Thurmont Police contacted the suspect and gained corroboration from him of the assaults. The suspect was identified as: Mark Devi Salatto, age 53, of Emmitsburg. Mr. Salatto was arrested and charged with: 2 Cts of Second Degree Assault; False Imprisonment. He is currently being held under No Bond; awaiting a bond review.
