## Media Release

On March 10, 2020 at approximately 1:10 am, Thurmont Police Officers responded to the Dollar General at 218 N. Church St. for a Burglary Alarm. Upon their arrival, the officers found a suspect coming from the rear of the store with a backpack. The suspect was detained. The officers found the rear door of the business had been forced open and the suspect had numerous stolen items in the backpack. The suspect was identified as: David P. Nolte, age 24, Jefferson, Md. The suspect was transported to Central Booking and has been charged with: 2cts of Breaking and Entering; 2cts of Destruction of Property; 2cts of Theft \$100 - \$1,500. Mr. Nolte is being held pending an Initial Hearing.
