Media Release

July 6, 2018

On July 4, 2018, at approximately 4:30pm, Thurmont Police were notified of an armed robbery which had occurred at Water Street Apartments. The victim reported through his employer, that two subjects entered his apartment, held him a knife point, and stole his wallet containing a large sum of money. One of the suspects was known to the victim, which aided in the investigation. All suspects were identified, arrested, and charged. It was learned that the robbery had been pre-planned, and the female suspects provided transportation to and from the scene of the robbery. The suspects are: Brandon M. Gooden, age 19, of Thurmont; Joshua L. Toniolli, age 33, of Emmitsburg; Expunged, age 20, of Sabillasville; Ashelley D. Smith, age 32, of Fairfield, Pa.; and Danielle E. Albaugh, age 22, of Emmitsburg. They were charged with: Armed Robbery, Assault-First Degree, Theft: under \$25,000, Conspiracy-Armed Robbery, Conspiracy- Assault First Degree, Conspiracy-Theft: under \$25,000. Gooden and Toniolli are being held at the Frederick County Adult Detention Center without Bond.
