## Media Release

On Wednesday June 10, 2015 at approximately 11:45pm, Thurmont Police was called to a disturbance at 428 N. Church St. Upon arrival the officer found a female who was refusing to get out of a pickup truck until she was paid by the male operator. The male advised that the female was from an escort service and he was refusing to pay her any money. The officer ran a wanted check on the female and received confirmation that the female was wanted by Virginia Beach Police for a 2007 warrant. The female was taken into custody and transported to Central Booking. The female was identified as: Travonia Nicole Silmon-Gray, age 32, from Townsend, Delaware. It was also discovered that Maryland State Police had a warrant for Ms. Gray. Ms. Gray was served with the MSP warrant for: Driving without a License; and a Fugitive Warrant was served for Violation of Probation for Forgery of Checks. Ms. Gray is being held at the Frederick County Adult Detention Center pending extradition.
